NeckRide offers a Guaranteed Ride Home Program (GRH) that provides commuters who carpool, vanpool, or take public transit to work with a ride home when unexpected emergencies arise. Commuters who register with the GRH Program will be able to use it to get home for unexpected personal emergencies and unscheduled overtime-up to 4 times per year. You must sign up for this program.
